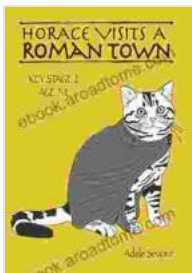


Horace Visits Roman Town Age 11 Years

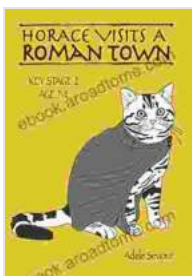

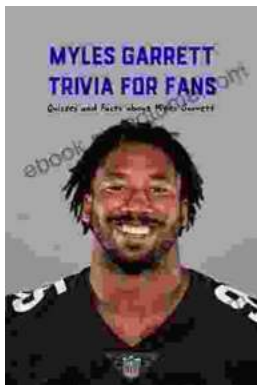
