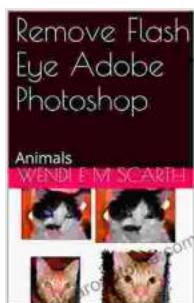


Remove Flash Eyes Adobe Photoshop

1. Open the image in Photoshop.
2. Create a new layer.
3. Use the Brush Tool to paint over the flash eyes.
4. Use the Eraser Tool to erase any mistakes.
5. Flatten the image.

Step 1: Open the Image in Photoshop

To open an image in Photoshop, click on the "File" menu and select "Open". Then, navigate to the image file on your computer and click on the "Open" button.

Step 2: Create a New Layer

To create a new layer, click on the "Layer" menu and select "New" > "Layer".

A new layer will be created above the background layer.

Once you are satisfied with the results, you can flatten the image. This will merge the new layer with the background layer.

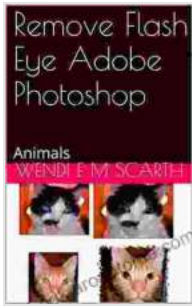
To flatten the image, click on the "Layer" menu and select "Flatten Image".
