


The New York Rangers: Images of Sports

The Original Six Era

The Original Six era of the NHL lasted from 1942 to 1967 and is considered by many to be the golden age of hockey. The Rangers were one of the six teams that made up the Original Six, and they were a perennial contender during this time. The Rangers reached the Stanley Cup Finals seven times during the Original Six era, winning the Cup in 1940 and 1950.

The Modern Era


