**S** **Supply Concerns:** critical test results, allergies, medication, etc.

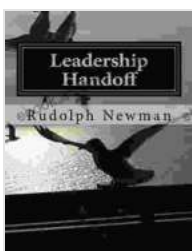
**B** **Background:** pertinent patient and family health history

**A** **Actions:** explanation of current situation that need to be

**T** **Timing:** level of urgency and timing of patient

**O** **Ownership:** responsible MD, nurse and family member

**N** **Next:** care plan and alternative anticipated changes

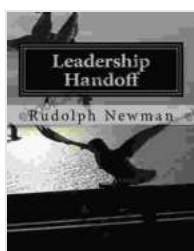
